The sing-out uniform was discussed at length (Jacket, Trousers, Shoes, Shirt, Belt, Tie)

Due to depreciation, it was decided that a member who joined in 1981 be charged £30

From January 1983 onward: It was agreed that all new members will pay £10 non-returnable for the 'hire' of a sing-out suit - all suits to remain the property of Preston BHG, and to be returned to the club in the event of a members resignation. Each current member owing money on suits, is asked to supply the date he received it, to the treasurer, Ken Appleby, in order to establish what should be charged.

It was recommended that club sweaters be worn at EVERY PRACTICE NIGHT to promote the 'club' image.

BADGES: Pin-on type. The Committee agreed to ask for members views, about the wearing of club badges (Club name, own name & singing part).

D Mahon: £10 suit refund, this has been returned by Dave with a request that it be 'improved'. The Committee decided not to change the £10 grant, due to other resigned members only having received £10 refund. (Some members had paid more than Dave, but only received £10 per the committee rule) A letter will be sent to Dave & his £10 cheque re-offered.

Ken Appleby has pointed out that the special 'Nationwide' Investment Account, is still in Bill Lawrenson's name, not our club. As such, this account enjoys a higher rate of interest. This Committee agreed that the 'Nationwide' investment should be altered to our club's name.

The Committee agreed that all new-comers be asked to pay 50p to the Treasurer on the 2nd & subsequent visits to our club. (Does not apply to other barbershop club members)

It was suggested that we look for new premises, prior to moving from the Plough.

The next Committee Meeting will be on Tuesday December 21st.

There being no further business, the meeting closed at 11-25p.m.
