### Lelystad in a nutshell

Lelystad, a new town in a new area. Named after the founder of the Zuider Zee Project, Dr. C. Lely. In 1965 the land reclamation began in the middle of a swampy area. In 1967 the first residents came. Now there are almost 55,000 people living here. Eventually there shall be at least 100,000 people who will make their home in a new town located on the bottom of the old Zuider Zee.

Lelystad is made up of various living quarters: a patchwork of neighbourhoods, each with its own character. They are connected to each other by town motorways. These roads are designed for motorized traffic. Slow-moving traffic can take advantage of a network of bicycle and walking paths. Due to this separated traffic system, Lelystad is a very safe town.

Remarkable is the vast greenery, the woods and parks, where an abundance of space is available for recreation. Along the IJssel Lake and on the Bovenwater, there are numerous water sport facilities available.

Lelystad is not yet ready. It hums everywhere from the building activities in the new living quarters and in the town centre. A dynamic town, which when ready will be above all a very liveable town built accordingly to its own specifications.

### Nature reserves

The **Oostvaarders plassen** are a unique nature reserve within Europe. They contain open lakes, swamp areas, closed reed fields and willow woods. Many thousands of birds forage or spend the winter here. Not open to the public.

From the Knardijk the area can be well observed. It can also be observed from the observation hut on the Buizerdweg.

**Larserbos.** Playing field. Playing ponds with small beaches. Fishing areas. Open to the public with the exception of the ANWB-Practice Area and two complexes of leisure residences.

**Knarbos.** Bicycle and walking paths. Playing field. Open to the public.

**Visvijverbos.** Bicycle and walking paths. Fishing areas. Open to the public.

**Overijsselse Hout** and **Hollandse Hout.** Bicycle and walking paths. Day camping. Playing fields. Open to the public.
